

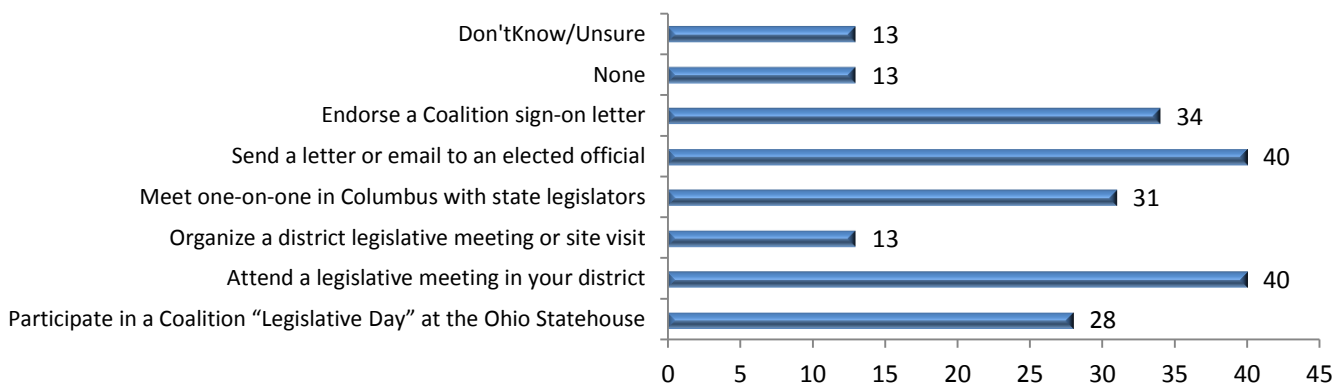


2011 OWC Stakeholder Survey Results Preview – 4/15/11
